

Environmental Services

This Public Health program provides services for food and water safety. Water testing kits are available for a small fee. Septic systems are also inspected for people installing new systems or purchasing property. The Health Department also does inspections for businesses serving food in the community and needing certification.

Emergency Preparedness

Being prepared for a disaster or a statewide emergency requires planning and resources to provide help when needed. The Health Department is engaged in training and education to prepare for disasters, pandemics, or threats to security.

Recycling Program

This program can take old TVs, small electronic appliances, and paint cans for safe disposal. The Health Department offers a place to bring those unwanted items in to be recycled. Please call ahead to schedule a drop off time at 309-627-2812.

Home Health Care

Home Health Care is skilled health care services provided in the home by trained nurses. These services are delivered according to a specific plan of care that is individualized for each patient. The plan of care includes a set of goals, based on a patient's medical and therapy needs. The program's mission is to help patients increase their ability to tend to their everyday needs while remaining in the comfort of their own



Hospice Care

The Hospice Care Program is designed to give support and compassion to patients and their families during the end-of-life phase with a focus on comfort and quality of life. The mission of this program is to keep patients comfortable, so that they can live each day as fully as possible.

The Hospice Team consists of a Hospice Physician, Clinical Coordinator, Certified Nurse's Assistant, Social Worker, Chaplain, and Volunteers.

Senior Services



Senior Services are available to residents needing companionship and help with activities of daily living. Tasks can include such activities as housekeeping, laundry, meal preparation, personal care, shopping, and errands. Income guidelines do apply, but private pay is also accepted. Funding for this program is provided by the Illinois Department on Aging under the Community Care Program (CCP).

Transportation



The Health Department has vehicles and drivers available for transportation for persons sixty years and older and their dependents. This can be for doctor appointments or shopping. This program is for pregnant and postpartum Women, Infants, & Children up to 5. It provides a great start to early nutrition and developing healthy habits.
